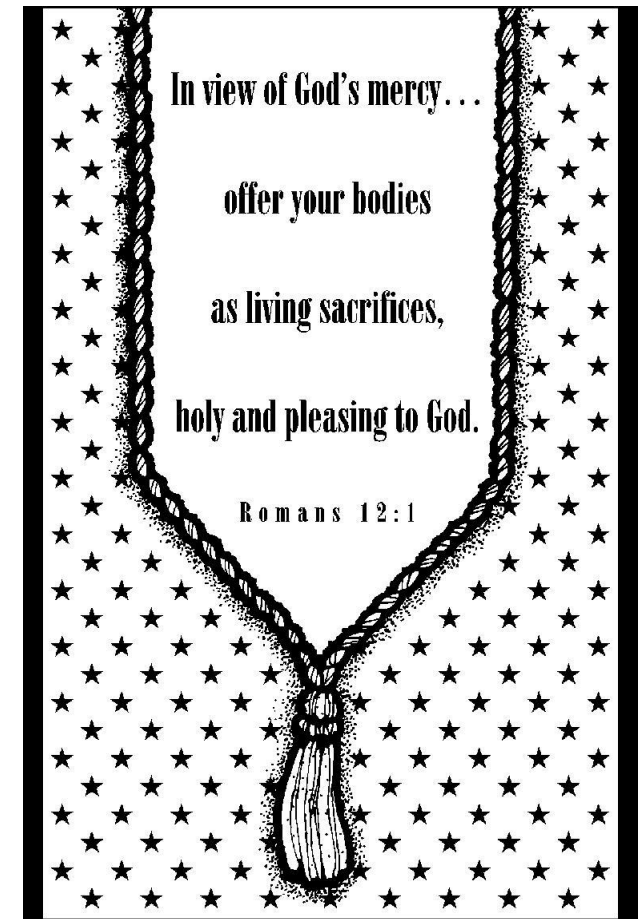

Does high soy milk intake reduce prostate cancer incidence? The Adventist Health Study (United States) Conclusions: Our study suggests that men with high consumption of soy milk (more than one cup a day) are at reduced risk of prostate cancer.
