Health Nugget

There appear to be no adverse side effects of eating too much whole fruit. The fiber in fruit may slow the release of naturally occurring fructose, and phytonutrients in fruit appear to block some of the uptake of sugars in the intestine. On the other hand, extracted fruit juice, like apple juice, may have the same deleterious effects as sugar water.
