Health Nugget

High blood pressure is the #1 risk factor for premature death in the world, affecting 1 in 3 adults. As we age, our pressures get higher and higher, such that by age 60, it strikes more than half of us. If it affects most of us as we get older, maybe it’s less a disease, and more of just an inevitable consequence of aging? No. We’ve known since the 1920s that high blood pressure need not occur. Researchers measured the blood pressures of a thousand people in rural Kenya who ate a diet centered around whole plant foods—whole grains, beans, vegetables, fruit, and dark green leafies. Our pressures go up as we age. Their pressures actually go down with age!
