Health Nugget

If perfect health depends upon perfect circulation, then perfect health depends on endothelial health. The endothelium is the inner lining of our blood vessels. We each have over 80,000 miles. It is a very active organ metabolically, affected negatively by oxidation and inflammation. Well, if it's all about oxidation and inflammation, then fruits and vegetables should help. And indeed they do. Each single serving of fruits or vegetables was associated with a 6% improvement in endothelial function. Both aerobic and resistance type exercise also proves to be very beneficial. Your endothelium doesn't care if you're on a bike or lifting weights, as long as you're getting physical activity --- and getting it regularly. If you stop exercising, your endothelial function plummets.
