Health Nugget

Not eating walnuts may double your risk of dying from heart disease, compared to consuming one or more servings a week. But walnut consumption only drops our cholesterol levels about 5%, so how can we get a 50% drop in cardiac mortality from just a 5% drop in cholesterol? Walnuts must have some other heart-protecting benefits. They do indeed. They improve arterial function. A clinical trial review of three studies analyzed the effect of nut intake on the ability of arteries to relax and open briskly. What effect did the nuts have? All three studies on walnuts showed a marked improvement in endothelial arterial function.
