Health Nugget

Last week we noted that the most comprehensive cancer research survey ever compiled recommended against using processed meats in the diet. Processed meat cannot only be thought of as a powerful multi-organ carcinogen, but may increase the risk of heart disease and diabetes as well. In the studies reviewed, red meat was bad, but processed meat was even worse, and that included white meats such as chicken and turkey slices. So, with more heart disease, cancer, and diabetes, it’s no surprise that processed meat consumption has been associated with increased risk of death.
