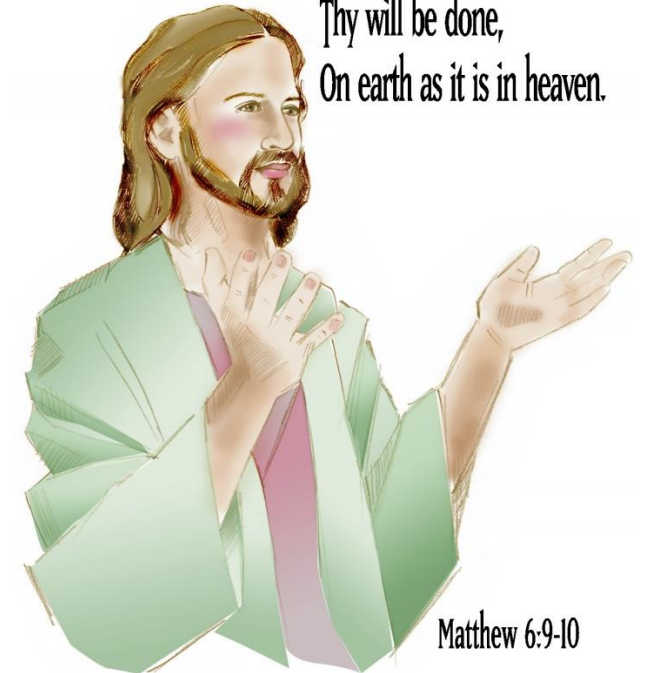

Health Nugget

Here is a great reason to eat healthfully. Rush University Medical School researchers published the results of a study that tracked 960 participants and found that the cognitive decline of people eating just 1.3 servings of leafy greens per day had much slower cognitive decline over time than did those that ignored dietary considerations. The difference was equivalent to being 11 years younger in age! For their study, a serving consisted of 1/2 cup of spinach, kale, or collard greens or 1 cup of lettuce. So if you want to be able to think and remember clearly as you grow older, the message is clear: eat your leafy greens.
