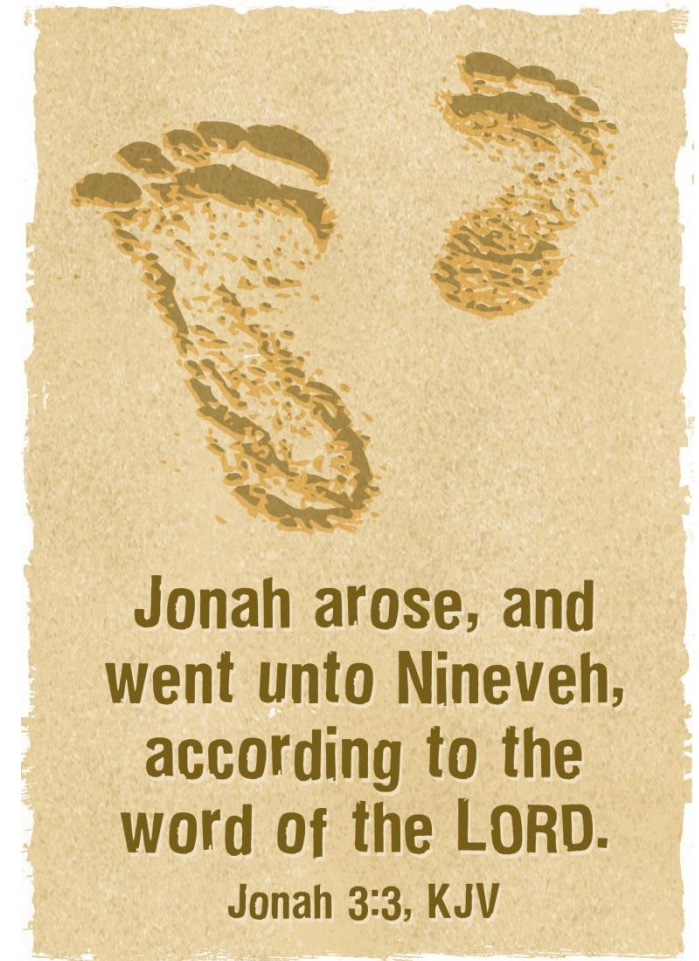

Tom Hensen



Tom started working in the oil field at age 14 in Texas while he was in High School. He continued oil field roughnecking until he went to an Arizona private school. There he joined the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association and tried his hand at riding bare-back broncs and Brahma bulls. Not seeing that as a life career, he went to college, didn't do well there and went back to the oil field to save enough money to go back to college. Tom graduated with an electronics degree, went to work for G.E. Medical systems and became an Electronic Medical Diagnostic Devices Engineer. He worked there for 17 years, moved to California after a divorce and went into business for himself doing the same thing -- selling, installing and repairing diagnostic x-ray systems. Tom was married for 19 years, and retired early to take care of his cancer-ridden wife, who passed in 2008 after being diagnosed with lung cancer for approximately two years. His puppy kept him company until she passed in August 2017. He misses them both very much.
