Health Nugget

Purpose in Life as a Predictor of Mortality Across Adulthood.
P.L. Hill, N.A. Turiano - Psychological Science, 2014 - journals.sagepub.com ...Using data from the longitudinal Midlife in the United States (MIDUS) sample. Proportional-hazards models demonstrated that purposeful individuals lived longer than their counterparts did during the 14 years after the baseline assessment, even when controlling for other markers of psychological wellbeing. Moreover, these longevity benefits did not appear to be conditional on the participants’ age, how long they lived during follow-up period, or whether or whether they had retired from the workforce. In other words, having a purpose in life appears to widely buffer against mortality risk across the adult years.
