Potatoes are the fourth most grown crop in the world, after the cereals rice, wheat, and maize, and are the only major food crop that is a tuber... Potatoes are a well-known source of Vitamin C, with a medium red-skinned potato (173 grams) providing about 36% of the RDA according to the USDA databases. Vitamin C has a major role in detoxifying reactive oxygen species in plants, which are the primary source of Vitamin C in the human diet.
