Conclusions of a cohort study (JACC) of 34,128 men, and 49,282 women aged 40-49 years done in Japan are as follows: "Our findings showed that skipping breakfast is associated with increasing risk of mortality from circulatory diseases and all causes among men and all causes mortality among women in Japan."
