

Health Nugget

A meta-analysis of eight studies involving a total of 106,935 participants, and 7419 patients with type 2 diabetes, compared breakfast skipping with the risk of type 2 diabetes. Conclusion: "Breakfast skipping is associated with a significantly increased risk of T2D. Regular breakfast consumption is potentially important for the prevention of T2D."
