Health Nugget

The relation between the sleep and the visuospatial skills was evaluated in 31 students from a public school. The visuospatial performance was evaluated by Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children (WISC-III), through the subtest Picture Completion, the Perceptual Organization Index and the Performance IQ Scale. In accordance with the results, 72% of the students presented regular sleep and good sleep length.
