In a 2015 meta analysis, "a total of 141 articles (110 unique samples), including 592,215 unique participants from 40 different countries, met inclusion criteria. Overall, longer sleep duration was associated with lower adiposity indicators, better emotional regulation, better academic achievement, and better quality of life/well-being." *Ref.: Systematic review of the relationships between sleep duration and health indicators in school-aged children and youth.
