Health Nugget

All animals appear to establish mutually beneficial relationships with microorganisms, and, within us, the trillions of good bacteria in our gut can be thought of as a forgotten, additional organ of the body — an organ that metabolizes, detoxifies, and activates many crucial components of our diet. Since diet is so important to our health, it is not surprising that what we eat determines the health of our gut and the types of bacteria, good or bad, that reside in our intestines. The makeup of our "microbiome", as it is called, is crucial to our overall health and you might easily guess what type of diet has been associated with the presence of healthy bacteria and what type of diet promotes the very opposite.
