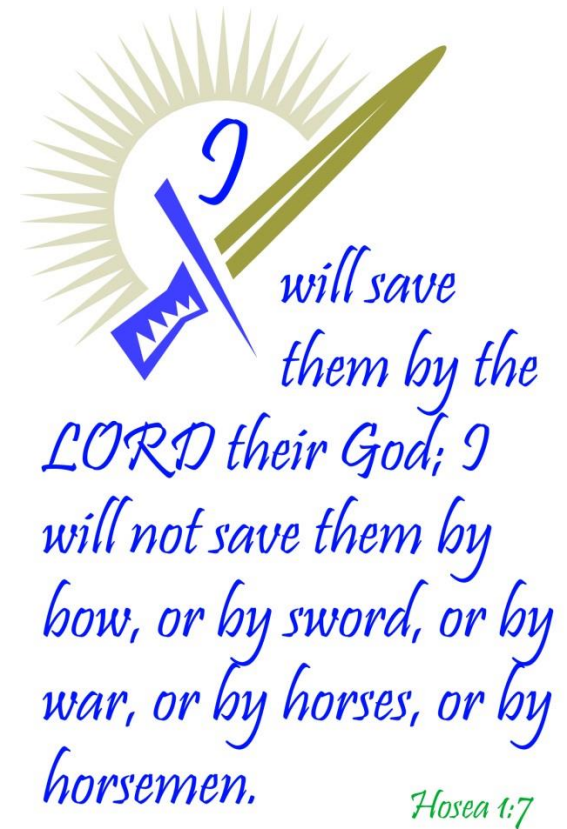

### Health Nugget

What happens to our gut flora microbiome when we’re on a plant-based versus animal-based diet? Researchers have found that adherence to a strict vegetarian diet resulted in reduced intestinal inflammation, suggesting a promotion of homeostatis, the keeping of a healthy balance of bacteria in our gut microbiome. In contrast, an animal-based diet was found to contribute to: 1) growth of disease-associated species, like *Bilophila wadsworthia*, which is associated with inflammatory bowel disease, Crohn's disease, and ulcerative colitis, among other serious gut diseases, and 2) *A. putredinis*, found in abscesses and appendicitis, as well as to 3) a decrease in health-promoting fiber-eating bacteria.
