Health Nugget

The human gut has a diverse collection of microorganism making up around 1,000 species, with each individual presenting with his or her own unique collection. Simply put, the bacteria are determined by what we eat. Eat fiber, and the fiber-munching bacteria multiply, and we get more anti-inflammatory, anti-cancer short-chain fatty acids. Eat less fiber, less whole plant foods, and our fiber eating bacteria starve away. What’s more, there appear to be only two types of people in the world: those who have Bacteroides type of bacteria (the bad guys) in their colon, and those whose colons are overwhelmingly home to Prevotella species (the good guys) instead. It’s amazing that with so many hundreds of types of bacteria, people settle into just one of two categories. Which category are you?
