Health Nugget

A prospective cohort study of 17,321 Harvard male alumni with an average age of 46 years was done comparing their reported physical activities with their longevity. Vigorous activity, (greater than or equal to 6 MET score) and nonvigorous (<6 met score). The study was done from 1962 to 1988. **Conclusions:** These data demonstrate a graded inverse relationship between total physical activity and mortality. Furthermore, vigorous activities but not nonvigorous activities were associated with longevity. These findings pertain only to all cause mortality; nonvigorous exercise has been shown to benefit other aspects of health.
