

# **Health Nugget**

In a large observational study done on 519,978 individuals between 25 and 70 years of age taking part in the EPIC study relative risk of colorectal cancer related to the use of fiber was assessed. Interpretation: "In populations with low average intake of dietary fibre, an approximate doubling of total fibre intake from foods could reduce the risk of colorectal cancer by 40%." Dietary fibre in food and protection against colorectal cancer in the European Prospective Investigation into Cancer and Nutrition (EPIC): an observational study.
