Health Nuggett

A study on 2332 men ages 42-60 years of age at baseline living in eastern Finland and followed-up on average for 19.3 years, with glucose tolerance testing done at 4, 11, and 20 years after baseline; was done to assess egg consumption and risk of incident type 2 diabetes. “Conclusion: Higher egg intake was associated with a lower risk of T2D in this cohort of middle-age and older men.” *Ref. Am J Clin Nutr 2015;101:1088-96.*
