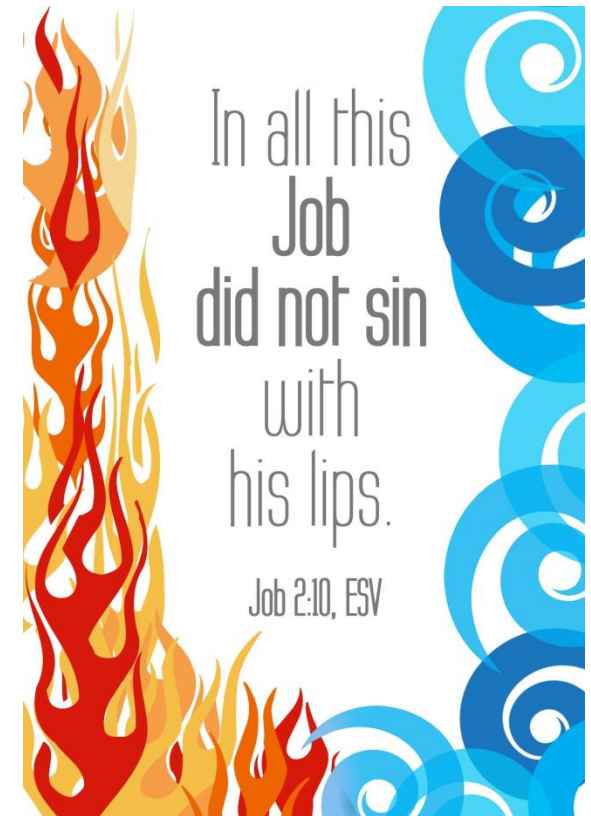

Health Nugget

Mexico implemented a 1 peso per liter excise tax on sugar-sweetened beverages on January 1, 2014. . . In this study we estimated changes in beverage purchases for 2014 and 2015. Purchases of taxed beverages decreased 5.5 percent in 2014 and 9.7 percent in 2015, yielding an average reduction of 7.6 percent over the study period. The study also mentioned that the lower socioeconomic class changed behavior more than the higher class. Ref. *Health Affairs, Vol. 36, No. 3: Delivery System Innovation*
