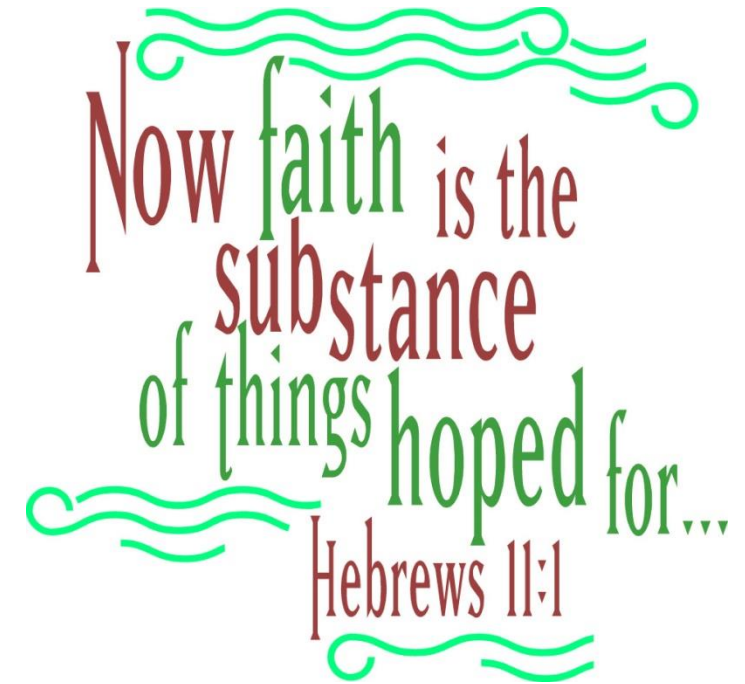

Health Nugget

A recent U.S. observational study of 15,428 adults 45-64 years of age followed for 25 years looked at the affect of low, moderate, and high carbohydrate diets on mortality. Analysis of the data showed that the lowest mortality was associated with a percent of energy consumed from carbohydrate between 50% and 55%. It was also shown that plant based sources of carbohydrate extended the lifespan while animal based sources shortened it. Ref. *Dietary Carbohydrate Intake and Mortality: A Prospective Cohort Study and Meta-Analysis; The Lancet Public Health, dated 17 August 2018*
