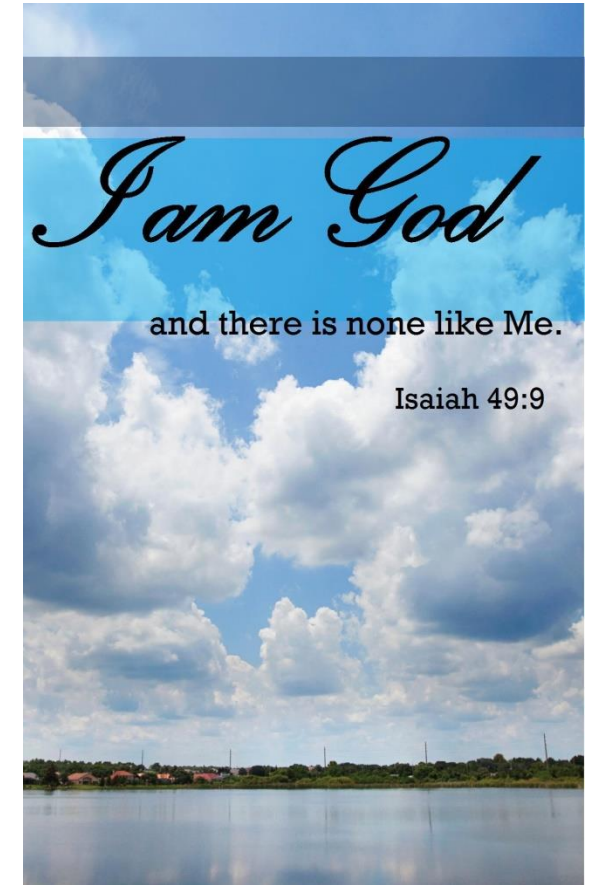

Health Nugget

Effect of Aspirin on Disability-free Survival in the Healthy Elderly. A total of 19,114 persons with a median age of 74 years were enrolled, of whom 9525 were randomly assigned to receive aspirin and 9589 to receive placebo and were followed for 5 years. Conclusion: Aspirin use in healthy elderly persons did not prolong disability-free survival over a period of 5 years but led to a higher rate of major hemorrhage than placebo. Ref.: *NEJM, October, 18, 2018 pp 1499-1508, The ASPREE Investigator Group.*
