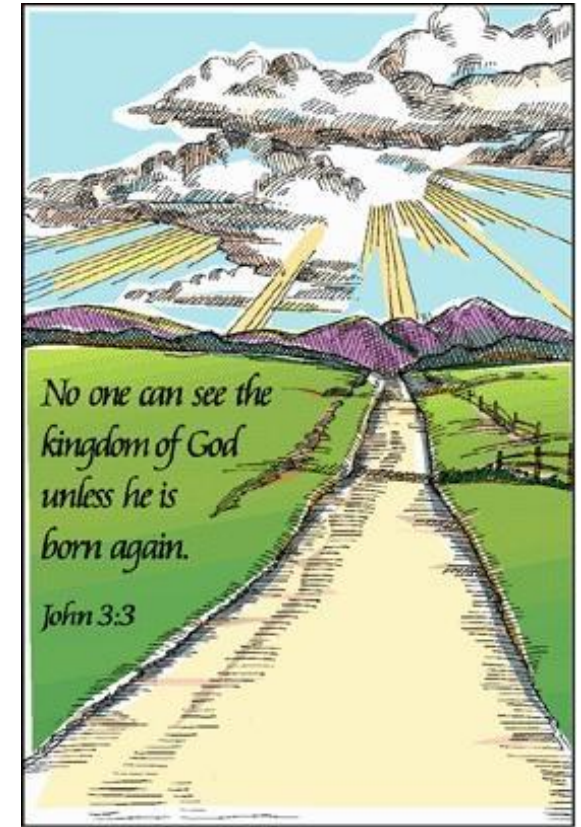

A meta-analysis of 8 observational studies involving 106,935 participants, and 7419 patients with type 2 diabetes was done. "Conclusions: Breakfast skipping is associated with a significantly increased risk of T2D. Regular breakfast consumption is potentially important for the prevention of T2D."
