Health Nugget

A study was done on the relationship of breast cancer to consumption of sugary beverages. "During 106,189 person-years follow-up, 100 incident cases of BC (breast cancer) were confirmed." The conclusion was that there was a direct relationship between sugary beverage consumption and breast cancer risk among women. Regular consumption of sugary beverages was associated with a significantly higher risk of breast cancer (Hazard ratio 2.12; 95% confidence interval. Ref.: Sugar-sweetened beverage consumption and incidence of breast cancer: the Seguimiento Universidad de Navarra (SUN) Project, European Journal of Nutrition PP 1-12. Fist online: 03 October 2018.
