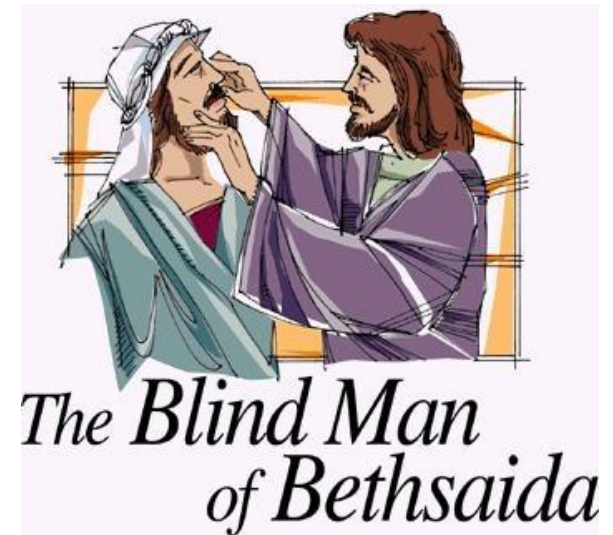

The results of a meta-analysis of 10 large randomized clinical trials involving almost 78,000 people at high risk of coronary heart disease showed that fish oil supplements did not reduce the risk of coronary heart disease deaths, nonfatal heart attacks, fatal or nonfatal strokes, revascularization procedures, or all-cause mortality.
