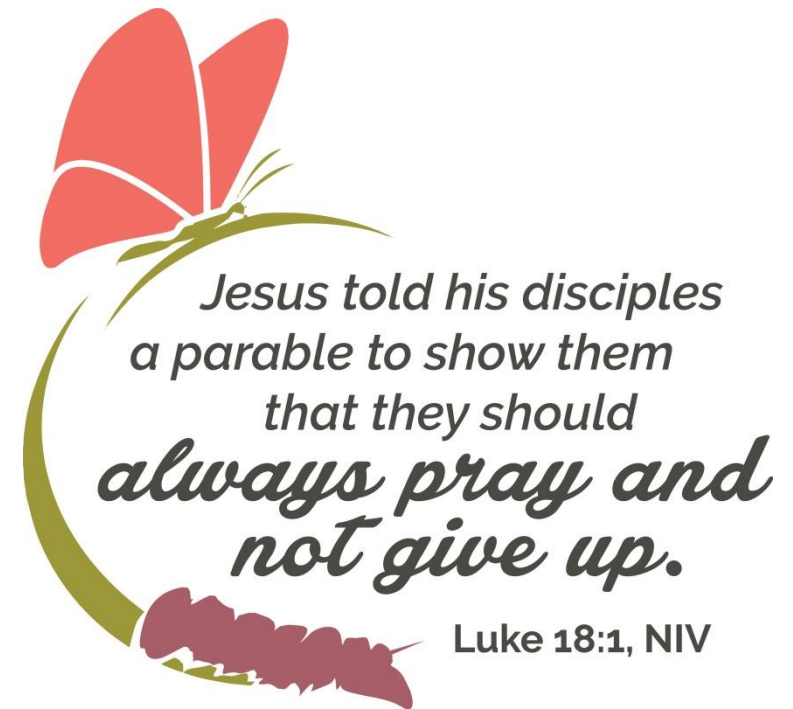

Health Nugget

In a prospective analysis of long-term coffee consumption, caffeine metabolism genetics, and risk of cardiovascular disease were studied in a prospective analysis of up to 347,077 individuals and 8368 cases, it was concluded that heavy coffee consumption was associated with a modest increase in CVD risk, but this risk was unaffected by genetic variants influencing caffeine metabolism. *Ref.
