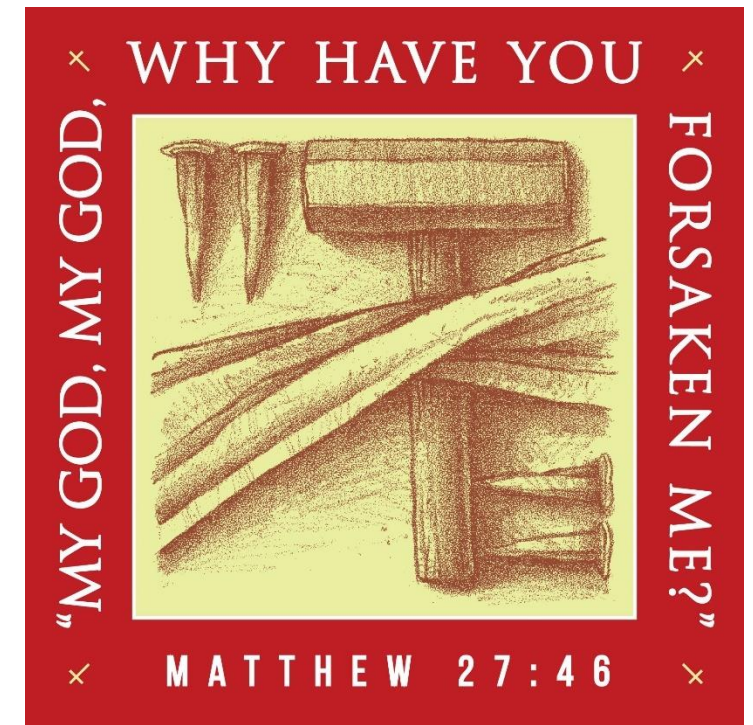

Health Nugget

Highlights of a study of 3549 college students; (1) Longitudinally analyzed sleep deprivation and college outcomes; (2) Two waves of large-scale US Wabash National Study were used; (3) Chronic sleep deprivation was associated with lower GPA; (4) Sleep deprivation from freshman to senior years negatively predicted graduation. *Ref.
