Religious Liberty

Washington Times June 10, 2019: The Supreme Court rejected a case Monday brought by an atheist who wanted to scrub “In God We Trust,” the U.S. motto, from the nation’s currency, claiming it was an entanglement of state and religion. On behalf of a group of atheists, Mr. Newdow argued America’s money lacked an reference to God until 1864, when it was added in. He said that amounted to an endorsement of religion. “By mandating the inscription of facially religious text ... on every coin and currency bill, defendants have turned petitioners – among whom are nine children – into ‘political outsiders’ on the basis of their most fundamental religious tenet,” he argued in his petition to the Supreme Court. The justices rejected his petition without comment.
