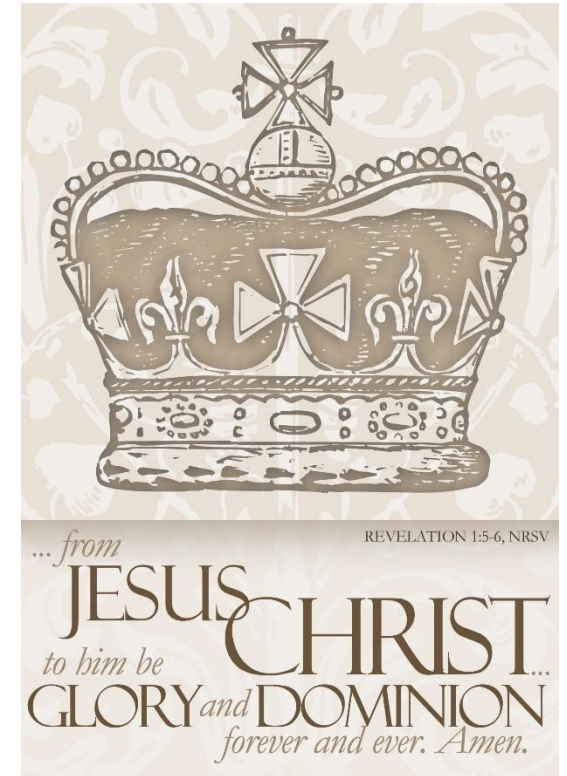

Health Nugget

Update on 2019 coronavirus now named COVID-19 as of 2/12/2020. The World Health Organization has declared this a world-wide emergency. On Jan 31, The U.S. Dept of Health and Human Services has declared this issue a public health emergency. It is estimated that 2% of those infected with the virus will die. In China about 17% of hospitalized patients with the virus have died. More people have died from this virus than from SARS. There have been more than 1,100 deaths so far. There is no known effective treatment or vaccine. Only control available is quarantine. There have been 14 cases in the U.S. with a total of 1357 deaths with nearly 60,000 persons infected. *Bob Scharffenberg, M.D., M.P.H.*
